BEST RED

Vistamar Sepia Reserva Carmenère 2008

Maipo

An especially generous view for such a low-priced wine. For what you paid, you will receive a complex nose that goes beyond the merely fruity or herbal flavours of the Carmenère, and moves deeper into notes of leather and meat. It is strong and syrupy in the mouth, but crossed at the same time with a sparkling acidity. Impossible to ask more for the price. A great bet from this brand.

BEST CARMENÈRE

Vistamar Sepia Reserva Carmenère 2008

Maipo

The aromas of leather blend with the flavours and notes of black fruits in this rounded, generous wine that also offers a good acidity. And please bear the price in mind: there are few wines like this on the market at that price, so if I were you, I would buy a few bottles and see how they age for at least three or four years.
